(You must qualify in order to receive a qualifying ribbon or rosette.)

A title rosette will be available to dogs obtaining their MX or MXJ title at the IPOC trial.

A Bar and Title Ribbon will be awarded to teams earning their **Master Agility Championship** at the USDTC Agility Trial. A Bar and Ribbon will be awarded for dogs earning their **PAX and PACH**

BITCHES IN SEASON ONLY will receive a refund upon receipt of a written statement From a Veterinarian **no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial**, a refund will be made minus a \$8.00 per day processing fee. Refunds will not be issued for any other reason

ONLINE ENTRY INFORMATION

YOU CAN ENTER THE TRIAL VIA LAB TESTED ONLINE ENTRY SERVICE. Go to the website Online Entry Services home page at LABTESTEDONLINE.COM and follow the instructions there to enter this event online.

(Please note that LabTestedOnline charges a small processing fee for online entries.)

During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 100 runs Online and 250 Paper entries for both days. If either form of entry (paper or online) has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

**** NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS ****

Entry Fees: \$25.00 for first entry \$15.00 for any additional runs of the same dog on the same day (includes \$4.50 per run for AKC recording fees).

All fees are to be payable in **U.S. Funds.**

ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.

ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS-Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after published closing date.

TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted and **WILL BE RETURNED.**

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of

the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE and WILL BE RETURNED!**

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, It is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to Judging. **DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further Judging will be excused.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Clubs have no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

DOGS PRESENT will not be permitted to roam. Dogs must use the designated exercise area.

TRIAL COMMITTEE will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations For Agility Trials.

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

Directions: From the South: I-275 south to exit #25 (38th Ave N), Go West on 38th Ave. Turn right (north) on 34th St N (US 19). (Hardees on left). Go over overpass and turn left into the first parking lot

From the North: I-275 south to 54th Ave N (Exit 26) Turn right and go west on 54th Ave N to 34th St N (US 19). Turn left onto 34th St N and turn into the parking lot on right just before the overpass.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS:

Exhibitors are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. In the Regular classes, dogs may be entered at the jump height for which their measurement qualifies them or a higher jump height, if the exhibitor chooses. In the Preferred classes, however, dogs must run in the jump height for which their actual measurement qualifies them.

***Dogs may **NOT** be entered in this class if they are 22 inches and under.

Dogs may be entered at this height at their owner's discretion if their measurement is 22 inches or under at the withers. 24 CHOICE

Move-Ups

Move-ups to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, must be received at the trial secretary's address no later than 6PM on Monday, April 20, 2026.

Any move-ups from over the weekend must be received by the Trial Secretary Trial on Saturday. **DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE LAST MINUTE!!!** No moving down or changing or height after closing except as specified in Chapter 1 Section 21 of the AKC Regulations For Agility Trials.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is available for all classes. FEO is 45 seconds for all classes (including T2B), except FAST – where the times will remain the same.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

(Note: This section only needs to be published in the Premium List if the Club is offering FEO.)

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.
